

Supply List for Laura Prim's Theater Arts Classes 2023-2024

Supply details are located at the bottom of the page

FOR EVERY STUDENT/EVERY CLASS:

- **Refillable Water Bottle**
 - *This is for all classes, rehearsals and performances*
 - *Must have student's name on it*
 - *There are filtered bottle filling stations all over the school and backstage in the DJD.*
 - *The department will no longer provide bottled water for rehearsals, shows, etc. and students will need to fill bottles before class.*
 - *Students will need to take bottles home periodically to clean!*

7th & 8th Grade: (SPRING SEMESTER ONLY)

- **Coveralls/Overalls**
 - *Large variety of colors/brands/prices on Amazon.com*
 - *Brands include Dickies, Red Kap, Natural Uniform, etc.*
 - *Short Sleeve & large enough to fit over street clothing is preferable*
- **Crew Uniform**
 - *black jeans or sturdy pants with pockets (not leggings), black long sleeve crew neck top, black crew socks, solid black shoes; optional: black hoodie/sweater/jacket over black crew neck t-shirt*

9th through 12th Grade: (ALL YEAR)

- **Coveralls/Overalls**
- **Athletic shoes or work boots that tie on the feet**
- **Crew Uniform**
- **1-2" Hardcover 3-Ring Binder (10th Grade Only)**

For 11th Grade: *NOT CURRENTLY REQUIRED BUT STRONGLY ENCOURAGED.*

- **Laptop Computer with the following minimum specifications:**

 - This will need to be a laptop -- PC or Mac – no tablets or Chromebooks
 - In Addition: Students are expected to understand basic computer functions and know how to maintain their computers – making sure that they regularly update browsers/operating systems, apps/programs; have enough RAM and memory for school work and required programs and assignments; how to run anti-virus software and how to avoid malware, etc.
 - They are also required to have their chargers available every class.

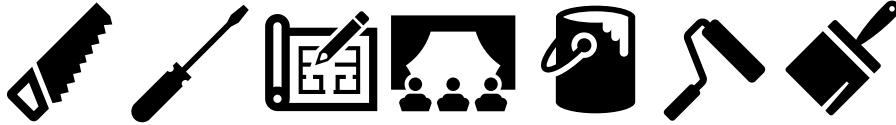
6th Period Tech Theater Class Students:

- Athletic shoes or work boots that tie on the feet
- Clothing appropriate to climb, crawl, get dirty and get paint on
- TBD: Crew Uniform (see details below) – *working backstage is a requirement for this class*
- *Optional -- Coveralls/Overalls*

For Theatre Students Focusing on Design/Production:

- Architect's Scale Ruler

- 18" Flexible Stainless-Steel Ruler
- 8" Plastic Drafting Triangle
- Portfolio – ITOYA Storage/Display Book Art Portfolio 14x17
- Optional: Laptop Computer with the following advanced specifications:

Supply Details (all students):

- Coveralls or Overalls
 - Dickies brand or similar
 - Long pants (required), short sleeves (recommended)
 - Either option should have a crew neck shirt underneath
- Athletic shoes or work boots that tie on the feet.
 - Shoes must cover the entire foot.
- Crew Uniform:
 - All of this clothing must be solid black.
 - None of this clothing may have writing, other colors, shiny zippers/buttons, etc.
 - Uniform should consist of: long sleeve, high-crew neck t-shirt; ankle length pants/jeans (pockets strongly suggested); optional -- sweater/jacket.
 - Socks high enough to cover area between top of shoe and bottom of pant legs must be worn; shoes should also be completely black.

Supply Details (Design/Production focused Theatre students):

- Architect's Scale Ruler
 - *An architect's scale is in feet/inches but has the same three-sided triangle shape as an engineer's scale ruler which will not work.*
- 18 Inch Long Flexible Stainless Steel Ruler
 - *Please do not get one that is longer*
 - *Some have cork on the back, some to do not – either is fine*
- 8 Inch Plastic Drafting Triangle (*minimum - a larger one is fine, but smaller is not*)
- Portfolio – ITOYA Storage/Display Book Art Portfolio 14x17
 - *This exact size and brand of portfolio is required for storage and capacity purposes.*
 - *This portfolio will be used for all Design/Production classes through the 12th grade year.*
